



BOSTON AREA: TRANSPORTATION AND BAGGAGE INFORMATION

Location: The van pickup point is the Northbound Lexington Service Area on Route 128 (also called I-95). The Lexington Service Area is on the exit ramp between exits 30A and 30B. If you are traveling southbound, reverse direction at Exit 29 (Route 2) and head north to Exit 30A & 30B.

Time: The van will leave at 12:00 noon. Please be at the pickup location **by 11:30 am.**

Baggage: Campers may bring one small carry-on bag with them. All other bags **must** be shipped via Camp Baggage (www.campbaggage.com). Please remember that storage space is scarce in the cabins and campers are limited to two large duffels or suitcases. Excess belongings will be put in storage.

Cell Phones: We know many of the girls will have their cell phones with them so they can stay in touch during the ride to camp. Since we do not allow cell phones at camp, we will collect them upon arrival and put them in our camper safe for the summer. Please do not provide more than one phone to your daughter.

Check-in: The counselor chaperones will have a list of campers who should be on the van. Check in with them on arrival. Please notify us at check-in if your daughter has been exposed to any contagious diseases within 3 weeks of reaching camp.

Dress: Have campers wear comfortable clothes and shoes and bring a sweater for the bus.

Meals: The bus ride to camp is about 2.5 hours. Please pack a lunch for your daughter or have her eat beforehand. Camp will provide some light snacks and bottled water.

Medication: Medication should be sent to camp prior to the day of departure. If you must send medication with your child, please give it to the counselors at check-in. Do not put it in your child's luggage or give it to your child to give to the nurse when she arrives at camp.

Notification: You will receive a call from camp when your daughter has safely arrived.
